The following are the descriptions of the Spiritual Gifts assessment tool we will be using in the Fall.

As a mature believer, please help us find members of our body who will share how their gift(s) functions in the church. Please check below any gift you have been blessed with that you would be willing to share with a small group on how you use your gift and how you have grown in its use.

- **Helps:** ability to work with and support other Christian ministry efforts
- **Service:** ability to identify and meet the practical needs of others
- **Leadership:** ability to influence others according to the 'big picture' purpose, mission or plan
- **Administration:** ability to co-ordinate and organize people and tasks
- **Hospitality:** ability to make people feel 'at home' and welcome, cared for and part of the group
- **Discernment:** ability to perceive whether a person's actions originate from Godly, satanic, or merely human sources.
- **Faith:** ability to believe God with confidence for things unseen, spiritual growth and the will of God
- **Music:** ability to make a significant contribution to a worship experience through singing and playing instrument
- **Tongues/Interpretation:** ability to speak or interpret in a language which you never learned and communicate a divinely anointed message from God to unbelievers
- **Miracles:** ability to perform supernatural acts as an instrument or agent of God which alter the expected course of nature
- **Craftsmanship:** ability to use your hands and mind to benefit other believers through artistic, creative or a wide variety of construction arenas
- **Healing:** ability to be used as a human intermediary through whom God's supernatural power is applied to a person's physical or emotional needs
- **Giving:** ability to cheerfully and generously contribute personal resources to God's work
- **Mercy:** ability to feel sincere empathy and compassion in a way that results in practical relief for people's hurt, pain and suffering
- **Wisdom:** ability to discern the mind of Christ and apply scriptural truth to a specific situation in order to make the right choices and help others move in the right direction
- **Knowledge:** ability to seek out, gather, organize and clarify facts and ideas on a number of diverse subjects
- **Exhortation:** ability to appropriately communicate words of encouragement, challenge, or rebuke in the body of Christ
- **Teaching:** ability to employ a logical, systematic approach to biblical study in preparation for clearly communicating practical truth to the body of Christ
- **Pastor/Shepherd:** ability to assume responsibility for the spiritual growth and Christian community of a group of believers
- **Apostleship:** ability to provide spiritual leadership over a number of pastors and churches that result in tangible fruit of ministry
- **Missionary:** ability to minister effectively in cultures beyond your own
- **Prophecy:** ability to boldly declare the truth of God, regardless of the consequences, calling people to righteous living.
- **Evangelism:** ability to share the good news of Jesus Christ with others in such a way that many non-Christians believe in Christ and are converting to Christianity
- **Intercession:** ability to pray for significant lengths of time, on a regular basis, and often observe specific answers to those prayers
